Letter of Resignation from February 2020 Council List


I the undersigned TANJOH Fridrick Tetuh on my honour declare that

1. I have been a frontline militant of the SDF since my student's days in Yaounde Univerity between 1990/1991, ENS Annexe Bambili between 1991/1994, militant and activist in Mbiame between 1994/1998, Bafut from 1998 to 2007 and leader in Guzang from 2007 till date.
2. My militancy and activism have propelled me to climb and attain different socio-political and administrative leaders.
3. One of the leaders stated in 2 above is the position of Mayor Batibo Municipality which I whole heartedly and passionately handled despite the so many political machinations and witch hunting.
4. I acknowledge and appreciate the role of all and sundry to have elevated me to this position especially Rt Hon Joseph Mbahndam and His Excellency Ni John Fru Ndi.
5. SDF was founded on social democracy, a principle which ties very well with my Christian convictions as a confirmed Christian leader.

When I see celebrations of joy even by close ones instead of pity over kidnap, demand for ransom and even disasters like that of the fire incident in the compound of Rt Hon Joseph Mbahndam, I am forced to ask where our values have gone to. In addition, I ask myself why are all these firebrands who have been fighting for a better Anglophone course and are now being abducted here and there and those of us on permanent threatening list have become "big enablers" now because of orientations of vision for the solution of the stalemate.

After a profound reflection on my vision as a leader and considering what human life is, I have decided to RESIGN my position in the list of the SDF for the February 2020 Municipal elections and declare that I am not part of any appeal for the re-insertion of the SDF list by the Administrative court/ ELECAM.
